



Kaiser Permanente is dedicated to providing top-notch care to our members. With our groundbreaking approach to care, specialists and multidisciplinary teams work together to both prevent and treat diseases. Bolstered by innovative research and early detection, this approach fulfills our promise to members to provide personalized care that keeps them healthy—rather than just treating them in illness.

We know from our research that frequent monitoring and early detection are key to better health outcomes. That's why we lead the nation in cancer screenings—in 2022, **85%** of our members were screened for breast cancer, **80%** were screened for colon cancer, and **90%** were screened for cervical cancer. We also rank highest in the region for controlling blood pressure for **80%** of our eligible members.³

Our diverse group of 1,700+ physicians across the region are recruited from top medical schools. They practice in 50+ specialties and subspecialties such as cardiology, oncology, and more. Thanks to the relationship between Kaiser Foundation Health Plan and Permanente Medicine, our doctors are focused only on your employees' care instead of the administrative work that burdens other providers.



State-of-the-art medical facilities

With almost 40 medical centers throughout the region—each offering a number of services like primary and specialty care, pharmacy, lab, X-ray, and more—your employees can get the care they need in one trip.

We offer access to hospitals throughout the region, including our own <u>Urgent Care centers</u>. Several of them are **24/7 Advanced Urgent Care Centers**, including the **Capitol Hill** and **Tysons Corner** facilities. Advanced Urgent Care centers address non-life-threatening health concerns around the clock and offer in-house services that are typically unavailable in urgent care facilities, like CT scan, cardiac monitoring, and observation units.



Next Generation medical centers

Seamless virtual care that supports your employees' health

Between work and busy personal lives, it can be hard for your employees to stay on top of their health. At Kaiser Permanente, we make it easier with convenient access to virtual care. Our multiple telehealth options mean your employees can take care of a health need without missing time from work—which helps them stay productive.



Explore the many ways in which your employees can get care virtually, when and where they need it:

Video visits. Your employees can schedule video visits for a \$0 copay with physicians and providers for non-urgent and urgent symptoms that don't require an in-person visit.²

Get Care Now. 24/7 same-day virtual care is available for employees to see the next available physician, without an appointment.

E-visits. Answering a quick self-service questionnaire will get employees a physician's response in 2 hours. They can also self-schedule a COVID-19 test, COVID-19 vaccine, or flu shot appointment.

Chat with KP. Our click-to-chat service allows your employees to speak with an advice nurse. Available to members at no extra cost.

Email. Your employees can message their doctor's office with nonurgent questions anytime.

Phone appointment. Telephone visits are available to speak with primary care or emergency physicians by calling **800-777-7904** (TTY **711**).



Remote monitoring. Employees can have certain conditions monitored remotely by their physicians for real-time observation and quick response.

Care Away from Home. If your employees need care while traveling outside of the service area, they can call **951-268-3900** (not toll-free for international calls) with questions about how to get care.
